Chinese New Year also known as the Lunar New Year or the Spring Festival is the most important of the traditional Chinese holidays. It consists of a period of celebrations, starting on New Year's Day, celebrated on the first day of the first month of the Chinese calendar

Year of the Ox

Obverse

The obverse of the coin features the Raphael Maklouf effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II, sovereign of the Commonwealth and Pitcairn Islands the year '2009' and the denomination of NZ\$2.00.

The reverse features a engraved representation of a an ox (bull) with relief colour "Year of the Ox" "2009", "1 oz 999 silver".
